


MDVR INSTALLATION



HARDWARE CHECK

Is everything required available?


Before starting you need all items required to complete the installation: DVR Host (the main device), cameras from 1 - 8, cables long enough to reach each camera, accessories such as GPS, monitor etc.



SCHEDULE THE INSTALL

Set aside the time to do the work

DVR installation can take some time depending on all of the factors. Make sure that the truck is available as it will be off the road for this period. Check availability of installation staff. If time is short some work may be done in advance; run cables, mount cameras to save time.



HARDWARE LOCATION

Determine the best location

DVRs are usually in the cab but should be accessible to remove the hard drive.

Cameras must be mounted with a clear view so check that other equipment will not interfere with this when operating.

INSTALLATION

Get the work done

Mount the hardware, run the camera cables, get power to the DVR. Sounds easy but cables may require protection, finding ignition power can be a challenge on new trucks and camera vision needs to be checked before completion,





FINAL CHECKS

Check everything is correct

Making sure that everything works may be harder than thought. Do you have a screen to check the video?

Who will check the hard drive files? Do a full operational test of the truck to make sure nothing has been missed.
